First Grade Supply List

- 1 pencil pouch (approx. 10" x 7") and a basic pencil box (approx. 8" x 5" x 2")
- 1 large, white eraser (1" x 2.5") and 1 package of white, pencil cap erasers
- 1 package yellow Ticonderoga pencils (about 20- sharpened, if possible)
- 4-pack, black, FINE_point dry erase markers (Expo works the best...colors/other brands do not cleanly erase from our whiteboards.)
- 1 kid's scissors
- 12 small glue sticks
- 1 box Crayola crayons (The 24-pack fits our crayon containers perfectly. 😊)
- 1 box Crayola colored pencils (12-pack or less)
- 1 box Crayola washable markers (10-pack, classic colors)
- 1 Crayola paint set with paint brush (8 colors)
- 2 plastic folders with 2 pockets, (2 different colors; MEAD or similar brands usually last the whole year.)
- 0.5 inch, 3-ring binder with an inside pocket
- Extra change of clothes (fits in a gallon zipper bag in bottom of backpack)
- Quiet indoor recess activities like small toys, games, coloring/activity books, puzzles, etc. (All items should be labeled and fit in a zipped, gallon-size, Ziploc bag. Thanks!)
